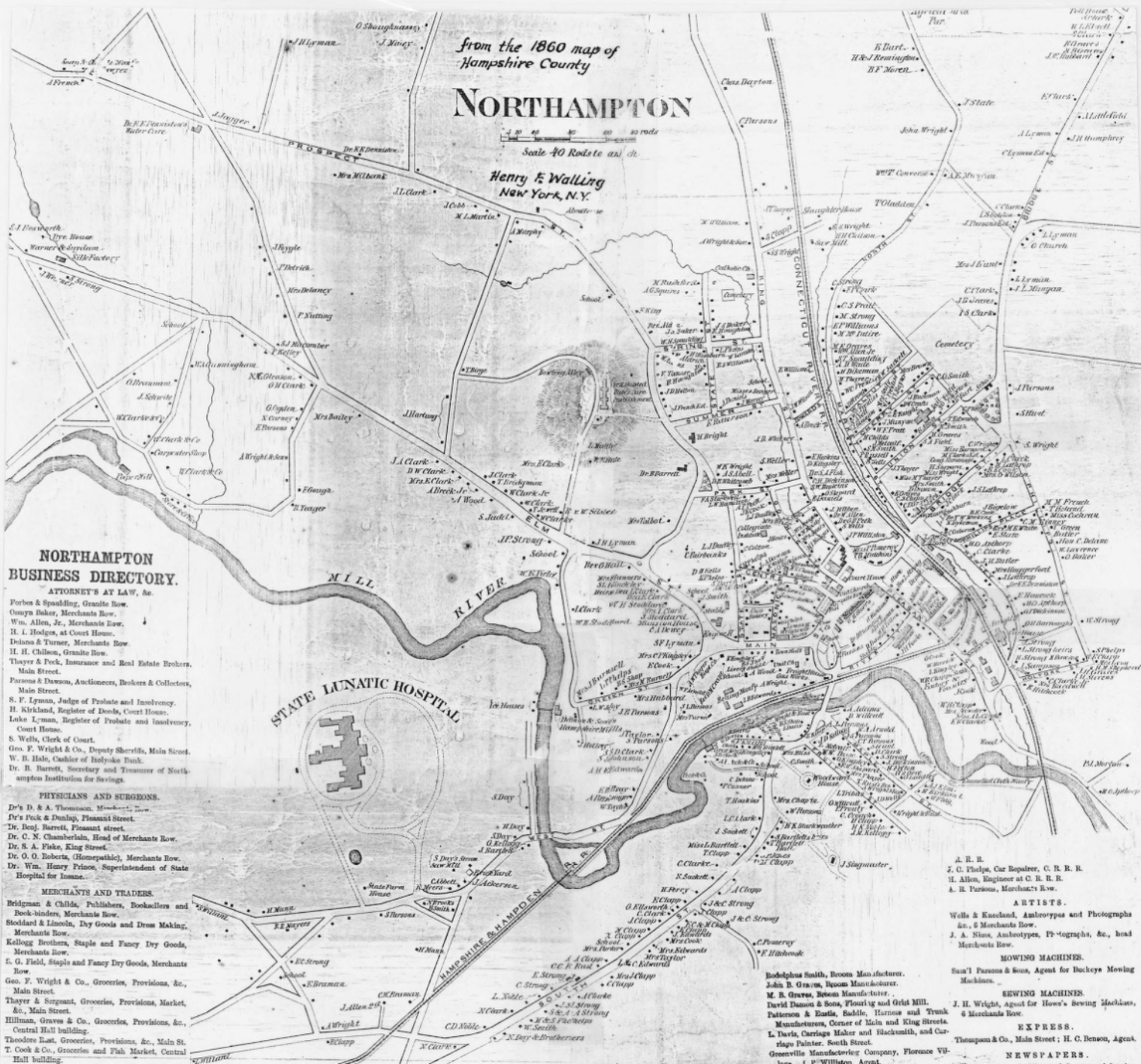


from the 1860 map of
